Leonardo Da Vinci

was an Italian artist, a scientist and an inventor who was born in 1452 in Anchiano in Italy and died in 1519 in France.

His most important works are La Gioconda, l'Ultima Cena, la Vergine delle Rocce, l' Uomo Vitruviano, La Dama con Ermellino.



Dante Alighieri is considered one of the most famous Italian writers, the father of the Italian language. His masterpiece is called "La Divina Commedia". Thanks to him, Italian language from Florence became the language of all Italian people.

Roberto Benigni is an actor and a film director. He won 2 Oscars in 1999, as best actor, and his most important film "La vita è bella" as best foreign language film. It's the story of a Jew and his family in a German concentration camp.





Federico Fellini was born in Rimini in 1920 He was an Italian film director. "Amarcord" and "La Dolce Vita" are some of his most famous films. When he was a child, he spent his summer at his grandparents' house in our town, Gambettola, and the house is still here.
